Housing Provided:

Housing Information:	The host company assists participants with finding apartments/ housing with kitchen amenities. Apartment size varies depending on number of students sharing the apartment. The host company helps to locate apartments within walking distance or near bus transportation. It costs approximately \$1.50 to ride the bus. All housing is within walking distance of grocery stores, entertainment, banks, restaurants, etc. Some furniture is provided by donations from employer however housing is mostly unfurnished. Host company can suggest second hand stores for affordable furniture purchase.
Housing costs (estimate):	\$125-\$250 per month per person.
Additional costs:	About \$200
Housing features:	Housing is mostly unfurnished but host company assists participants in finding affordable furniture. Host company will try to help find housing that has kitchen facilities. Actual cost of housing will be determined by the number of participants sharing the housing space. On average one apartment may cost \$500-\$700 and that would be split between approximately 4 participants.
